In their accumulation, the images reconstruct and illuminate the active unconscious of our cities, which is not explicit in its enunciation but does not stop being executed firmly.


The Splash


This series puts special attention to the involuntary gesture of painting and elevates these signs to the creative act. Emphasizing its aesthetic qualities.


























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
